



Safe Sanctuaries & Health Policy For Enterprise First United Methodist Church

In our church nursery program, we strive to maintain a healthy, clean and safe environment at all times. Children should be kept at home and not allowed to attend the nursery if they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- ** Diarrhea (in the past 24 hours)
- ** Vomiting (in the past 24 hours)
- ** Temperature above normal
- ** Sore throat
- ** Rash of unknown origin
- ** Skin infections
- ** Pink eye
- ** Green colored nasal discharge

If a child is brought to the nursery and becomes ill, the Nursery Director reserves the right to contact the parents/guardians and ask them to take the child home.

All parents/guardians will be required to obtain a beeper upon check-in of your child into the nursery, should an emergency arise. beepers will also be required to be presented at time of pick-up to ensure the secure retrieval of your child.

In compliance with our Safe Sanctuaries Policies and to ensure the safety of all children, NO Adults or Youth are allowed in the nursery classrooms other than our Certified Nursery Workers.
